EXODUS – Read Exodus 20:13-17 (page 94 of the journal) and then work through the following questions/activities:

1. Recite the Ten Commandments using the HAND GESTURES on the pink sheet you were given earlier.
2. Most of us can say that we have never murdered anyone. Does this mean that we have honored the *intent* of the sixth commandment? Look up Matthew 5:21-22. What other sins does Jesus associate with murder? How are these sins linked to the sin of murder?
3. Now REWRITE THE SIXTH COMMANDMENT AS A “DO” COMMAND. You may find Romans 12:18 helpful as you think through how to rephrase this command positively.
4. Why is God so concerned about preserving the marriage relationship? Look up Ephesians 5:25-33 to help with your answer.
5. Now REWRITE THE SEVENTH COMMANDMENT AS A “DO” COMMAND.
6. How does the eighth commandment flow logically from the seventh commandment?
7. Look up Luke 16:10. How does this verse apply to the issue of “minor” theft? What does it say about the way our hearts and minds work?
8. Now REWRITE THE EIGHTH COMMANDMENT AS A “DO” COMMAND.
